How To Share Your Faith Without Fear

Step 1: Raise Questions

- 1. Do you have any kind of spiritual belief?
- 2. To you, who is Jesus?
- 3. Do you think there is a heaven or hell?
- 4. If you died right now, where would you go?

If heaven: Why would God let you in?

If hell: Would you like to go to heaven?
If they don't know: Would you like to know?

5. Would you like to see what God says?

Open the Bible

Step 2: Read Scripture

Have the person read each one out loud. With each scripture, ask: "What does this say to you?" If there is any question on a scripture, have them *Read it Again*.

- 1. Romans 3:23 All does that include **you**?
- 2. Romans 6:23 Notice, one sin sends us to Hell.
- 3. 1 Peter 2:24 **His** work on the Cross in our place.
- 4. Romans 10:9 If you confess Jesus as **your** Lord.
- 5. 1 John 5:13 You may **know** for certain.
- 6. Acts 2:37-39 What is God's **promise**?

What are we to do to **receive** forgiveness of sin?

Repent means to change our heart and life.

Baptism means to unite ourselves with Christ.

Step 3: Reach Commitment – Receiving Jesus Christ as your Savior and Lord

- 1. Are you a sinner?
- 2. Do you want forgiveness of sin?
- 3. Do you believe Jesus died on the cross for your sins and rose again?
- 4. Are you ready to have Jesus be your Savior and your Lord?
- 5. From the scriptures you just read, what do you need to do to go to Heaven? (Rom 10:9; Acts 2:38)
- 6. Are you ready to do that? (believe, confess Christ as your Lord, repent, be baptized into Christ)
- 7. Baptize them immediately into Christ. Acts 16:33
- 8. Help them discover their **privileges** and their **responsibilities** found in the New Testament.
